## Directions From Nashville to Coker Creek Village:

1. Merge onto I-40 E towards Knoxville
2. Take the TN-101/PEAVINE RD exit, EXIT 322, toward CROSSVILLE for 0.2 miles.
3. Keep RIGHT at the fork to go on PEAVINE RD/TN-101 for 0.4 miles.
4. Turn LEFT onto US-70/KNOXVILLE HWY/TN-1 for 6.7 miles.
5. Turn RIGHT onto COX VALLEY RD. For 3.4 miles.
6. Turn LEFT onto TN-68 for 16.8 miles.
7. Turn LEFT onto US-27/RHEA COUNTY HWY/TN-29/TN-68/1ST ST/J LON FOUST HWY. Continue to follow US-27 S/RHEA COUNTY HWY/TN-29 S/J LON FOUST HWY for 2.4 miles.
8. Turn LEFT onto TN-68/WATTS BAR HWY. Continue to follow TN-68 S for 57.2 miles.
9. *Your destination is 0.6 miles past COUNTY ROAD 618  
If you reach RURITAN RD you've gone about 0.3 miles too far.*

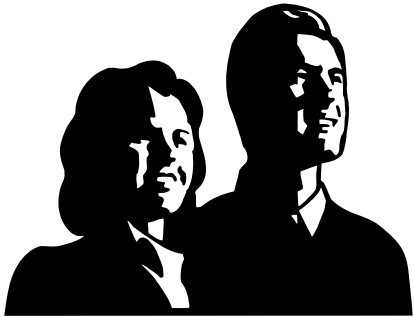
